### **What you can do**

#### Child-Sponsorship

With a monthly donation of at least € 30,-- you help us to support one child in a children’s village, that is all the cost for food, clothes, medical aid and everything else that a child needs.

As we want to guarantee a secure future for the children, we care deeply about their schooling. Only that way can we really fight the suffering of many children.

As a sponsor you contribute a great deal to that.

Apart from this sponsorship that is mainly based on financial help, **Kinderzukunft** gives you the possibility of an active sponsorship. That means you become an attachment figure for a child and stay in personal contact to your little protégé. It is this kind of warmth and human attention that is best in healing the emotional wounds of these little ones!

#### Village-Sponsorship

With a villagesponsorship of at least € 30,-- a month, you do not decide on a specific child, that you want to support, but help a whole village with your donation. You can choose which one of our three children’s villages you want to support: the one in Guatemala, Romania or Bosnia.

## Who we are

### *Rudolf Walther and his considerations*

Rudolf Walther was born in 1923 as the son of a farmer. After the war he worked on his parents' farm until he risked a professional reorientation during the 60s. He worked his way up to be the owner of one of the ten biggest furniture firms in Germany – "Möbel Walther". After many successful years, Rudolf Walther withdrew from the company so that he could spend more time on something that was very dear to his heart, that is helping children in need. In 1988 he formed **Kinderzukunft** as a sign of deep gratitude for the happy and content life that he was allowed to have.

## The foundation

The foundation is not only subject to official supervision by the government and the Inland Revenue office but also voluntarily to the special examination procedures of "DZI - Deutsches Zentralinstitut für soziale Fragen". The administrative overhead at **Kinderzukunft** is fully paid by Rudolf Walther, making sure that the full 100 % of the donations are used for the projects!

One of the many ambassadors of the foundation, Karl Eyerkauf, district administrator retd., who has been the godfather of a child in Guatemala for eight years, says:

## What we do

- We build children's villages for orphans and deserted children, where they can grow up safely and are cared for in a family-like community.
- We invest into a good school education for poor children, as help to self-help is the best way to insure that those children are able to cope with their own lives later on and can contribute to the development of their country. Therefore we build schools and training workshops and offer special courses.
- We have a complex system of sponsorships. Next to securing the financial needs of each child we especially try to give them the attention and affection they need. The godparents help to keep the children's homes and provide a good education.
